
## Avoid An Overpayment

## KNOW THE RETIREE HEALTH PLAN RULES

The TeamCare Retiree Health Plan is only available to retirees and dependents who are not eligible for Medicare (Part A, B, or D) which includes early-Medicare due to a Social Security Disability Benefit. The Retiree Health Plan is not a supplement to Medicare nor does it coordinate with Medicare. You or your covered dependent(s) cannot receive TeamCare Retiree Health Plan benefits while being eligible for Medicare.



## **ALERT**

If either you or your covered dependent(s) are receiving TeamCare Retiree Health Plan benefits and have:



- Medicare (Part A, B or D), or
- Early-Medicare due to a disability, or
- □ Applied for a Social Security Disability Benefit

## YOU MUST NOTIFY TEAMCARE IMMEDIATELY

TEAMCARE WILL PURSUE ALL OVERPAYMENTS OF PAID CLAIMS
AS A RESULT OF NOT RECEIVING NOTIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR MEDICARE

To prevent an overpayment of paid claims and to comply with TeamCare and Medicare's eligibility rules, you can notify TeamCare either by phone, email, or fax and indicate your Medicare coverage start dates shown on your Medicare card:
